Technical Exercise submission list

All groups are played unaccompanied (without metronome or click).

Candidates will be marked on tone quality and consistency, maintenance of pulse, and accuracy. Performances slower than the stated minimum tempo may be subject to qualitative judgement by the examiner, according to extent and commensurate with the grade.

- For Debut there is no memory requirement
- For G1-G8 group A & B should be played from memory.
- For G1 the candidate should choose to play either natural minor or harmonic minor or melodic minor scales.
- For G2-G8 the candidate should play all natural minor, harmonic minor and melodic minor scales.

The candidate should choose one technical study (Group C) to perform.
 Any fingerings shown are suggestions only.

Scales (minimum tempo 126 bpm)
Hands together, from memory.
Play **all** natural minor, harmonic minor and melodic minor scales.

Note: Eight of the scales should be played with legato feel, rest with staccato feel.

The candidate may choose to play either scales 1, 2, 5, 7, 9, 11 and 13 (in F# major and D# minor) or 3, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12 and 14 (in Gb major and Eb minor) and then 15. (8 in total).

 Play **all** natural minor, harmonic minor and melodic minor scales.

Note: Seven of the scales should be played with legato feel, rest with staccato feel.

1. C# major (4 octaves)
2. C# major contrary motion (2 octaves)
3. Cb major (4 octaves)
4. Cb major contrary motion (2 octaves)
5. A# natural minor (4 octaves)
6. Ab natural minor (4 octaves)

Scales (minimum tempo 176 bpm)
 Hands together, from memory.

Note: Four of the scales should be played with legato feel, rest with staccato feel.

1. C half-whole diminished (two octaves)
2. C whole-half diminished (two octaves)

Additional scales from previous grades played in the indicated keys.

3. C# Major scale (4 octaves)
4. Cb Major scale (2 octave contrary motion)
5. A# Natural minor scale (4 octaves)
6. Ab Harmonic minor scale (4 octaves)
7. A# Melodic minor scale (4 octaves)
8. Chromatic scale (starting on any black key 4 octaves)

Group B

Arpeggios
 (minimum tempo 132 bpm)
 Hands together, from memory.

Note: Half the arpeggios should be played with legato feel, rest with staccato feel.

1. Diminished 7 (4 octaves) from the starting notes C, C# and D (3 in total)
2. Dominant 7 (4 octaves) from the starting notes G, D, A, F, Bb, Eb (6 in total)

Additional arpeggios from previous grades played in the indicated keys.

3. Major arpeggios (4 octaves) from the starting notes C#, Cb (2 in total)
4. Minor arpeggios (4 octaves) from the starting notes A#, Ab (2 in total)
