For chord exercises which are stipulated as being directed by the examiner, candidates must present all chords/voicings in all key centres. Candidates do not need to play these to click, but must be mindful of producing the chords clearly with minimal hesitancy between each.

### **Group A**

Scales (80 bpm)

For each scale, both fingerings should be represented.

### **Group B**

Arpeggios (80 bpm)

Prepared on starting notes A, B, C and D on the E string.

- 1. Major 7th
- 2. Minor 7th

Each chord performed on starting notes B, C and D on the E and A strings (18 chords in total).

- 1. Major 7th
- 2. Minor 7th

### **GRADE 6**

### **Group A**

Scales Two octaves Tempo: 100 bpm

- G minor pentatonic
  (5 positions)
- 2. B minor pentatonic (5 positions)

Modes Two octaves, two positions Tempo: 100 bpm

Candidates must play both modes listed from each of the 10 starting notes (G, G#/Ab, A, A#/Bb, B on the E string and C, C#/Db, D, D#/Eb and E on the A string) (20 in total).

- 1. Dorian
- 2. Mixolydian

### **Group B**

Arpeggios Two octaves, two positions Tempo: 100 bpm

Candidates must play all arpeggios listed from each of the 10 starting notes (G, G#/Ab, A, A#/Bb, B on the E string and C, C#/Db, D, D#/Eb and E on the A string) (30 in total).

Candidates to perform one technical study from the list below:

Example 1 – Rock and Pop - tapping and legato

Example 2 – Funk - staccato phrasing and 16th-note strumming

Example 3 – Jazz/Latin/ Blues - string bends and double-stops

Scales and Modes Two octaves, two positions Tempo: 100 bpm

Candidates must play all scales/modes listed from each of the 10 starting notes (G, G#/Ab, A, A#/Bb, B on the E string and C, C#/Db, D, D#/Eb and E on the A string) (30 in total).

- 2. Phrygian
- 3. Jazz melodic minor

Scales Two octaves, two positions Tempo: 100 bpm

Candidates must play all scales listed from each of the 10 starting notes (G, G#/Ab, A, A#/Bb, B on the E string and C, C#/Db, D, D#/Eb and E on the A string) (30 in total).

- 1. Whole tone
- 2. Diminished
- 3. Altered

#### **Group B**

**Arpeggios** One octave, two positions

Tempo: 100 bpm

Candidates must play

- The first three arpeggios listed starting on G, G#/Ab, A, on the E string,
- The second three arpeggios listed starting on A#/Bb, B on the E string
- The first three arpeggios listed starting on C, C#/Db, D on the A string
- The second three arpeggios listed starting on D#/Eb and E on the A string) (30 in total).
- 1. 1. Dominant7#5 arpeggio
- 2. 2. Dominant7b5 arpeggio
- 3. 3. Minor7b5 arpeggio
- 4. 4. Dominant7#9 arpeggio
- 5. 5. Dominant7b9 arpeggio
- 6. 6. Diminished arpeggio

- The second two chords starting on notes A#/Bb, B on the E string.

- The second two chords starting on notes D#/Eb, E on the A string (20 in total).
- 1. Dominant7#5
